Abstract submission

Those wishing to present Papers should send an Abstract of 350 to 400 words typed on A4 (210 x 297 mm) size paper, with a left margin, right margin and a top and bottom margin of 25 mm. The text shall be in Normal Times New Roman, font size 12, single spacing and fully justified. The Abstract should be e-mailed to: janitha@kln.ac.lk or larambewela@yahoo.co.uk by 31st January 2007. Notification of acceptance will be by 28th February 2007. The Full-length paper if necessary for the review process will be requested.

Instructions to Authors

The submitted Abstract and Full-length paper shall indicate the appropriate Conference theme and also conform to the following: provide title, names of authors and affiliation before the main body of the text. The Full-length paper should comprise an introduction, main body of text, conclusions, recommendations, acknowledgements and references. Both the Abstract and the Full-length paper should also carry mailing address, e-mail address, telephone and fax numbers at end of Abstract/Full-length paper.

Proceedings of Conference

An electronic copy of the Full-length paper should be submitted prior to presentation at the Conference. Authors are advised to note that only those papers that are submitted and presented at the Conference will be published in the Conference proceedings.
