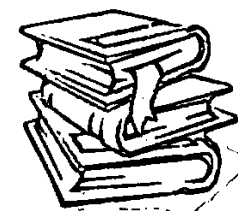

Chartered Chemist (C.Chem.) Designation

Under by-law 7 a Member or Fellow or an experienced Practising Chemist seeking the award of the designation of Chartered Chemist (C.Chem.) shall need to demonstrate a high level of competence and professionalism in the practice of Chemistry and show his/her commitment to maintain that expertise. He/She will need to have at least five years of professional experience subsequent to a good enhanced first degree or be able to demonstrate an equivalent level of attainment.

With effect of 01.07.01 the designation of Chartered Chemist is not automatically conferred on Fellows/Members. Those who wish to apply for Chartered Chemist status should contact the office.

Vacancies for (full day) Academics for the College of Chemical Sciences

Applications are invited until 10.10.06 from University Academics and those having equivalent qualifications for appointment as full day Academics in the College on the following terms and conditions. Attractive honorarium based on the university salary scale and College (Academic) honorarium will be paid.

- (a) Each appointment will be for a period of about 2 ½ to 3 months, during which the appointee will be expected to be present at the College premises for about 10 full days on Saturdays/Sundays/holidays and participate in teaching, tutoring, counseling, research/project supervision and academic administration etc. as may be deemed to be necessary by the Hony. Dean in consultation with the Registrar and as directed by the Academic Board.
- (b) Each appointee will usually be expected to conduct at least one (2 or 2 ½ hour) lecture and one (3-5 hour) practical session on each working day. When free from lectures/practicals classes the appointee will be expected to participate in other academic work (tutorial/counseling/project supervision) and academic administration.
- (c) The scheme is expected to first commence towards the latter part of 2006 or early 2007.
