Symplocus racemosa (Sinh. Lotsumulu), belonging to the natural order Styraceae is used in indigenous medicine in "phlegmatic diseases and Leprosy". From the petroleum ether extract of the bark of *Symplocus racemosa*, oleanolic acid and acetyl oleanolic acids were isolated; the ether extract was mainly betulinic acid.
