

TRANSPORT - AS PART OF INFRA-STRUCTURE FOR SOUTH ASIAN
REGIONAL CO-OPERATION

The objective of this paper is to examine the transport sector in South Asian region bearing in mind, transport as part of infra-structure for regional economic co-operation in South Asia. It was observed that regional co-operation depends largely on regional trade for which an efficient transport network is a pre-requisite. The deficiencies in the transport systems in countries in South Asia have been a bottle-neck not only to regional traffic flows but also to development of individual economies. The present paper therefore, concludes that there is substantial scope for regional co-operation if adequate transport facilities are made available.
